DEFINITIONS

<u>Case</u>: someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.

Close Contact: anyone who has had one of the following: (i) contact with a person diagnosed with COVID-19; (ii) lives with someone with COVID-19; (iii) having spent two hours or longer in the same room or vehicle as someone with COVID-19; and (iv) having been face-to-face within sixfeet or less of someone with COVID-19 for more than 15-minutes in any other setting not listed above.

Quarantine: to separate people exposed to a contagious disease and restrict their movement to determine if symptoms develop during the incubation period for the particular infectious disease outbreak.

<u>Isolation:</u> separation of sick people with a contagious disease from people who are not sick.

Jemez Pueblo - 12 ACTIVE COVID-19 cases

Since the last update provided on October 26, 2020, the number of active cases and recovered cases have changed (refer to Bulletin #45). Below is the breakdown of the COVID-19 situation specific to Jemez Pueblo.

As a result of recent cases, <u>17</u> different households have been quarantined. As a reminder, please practice the following:

- Always wear a mask if you are around individuals who are NOT within your household.
- Always be mindful of hand hygiene by frequently washing your hands and/or use hand sanitizers.
- Avoid gatherings with individuals who are NOT within your household.
- Maintain a distance of 6 feet between yourself and others who are NOT within your household.

By following and practicing the above, you will reduce your risk of exposure to COVID-19 and reduce your risk of quarantine. It is your personal responsibility to ensure that you are safe from COVID-19. By doing each of our parts, the Jemez community can be minimally impacted from COVID-19.
