## <u>Jemez Pueblo</u> COVID-19 Cases UPDATE

### **DEFINITIONS**

<u>Case</u>: someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.

Close Contact: anyone who has had one of the following: (i) contact with a person diagnosed with COVID-19; (ii) lives with someone with COVID-19; (iii) having spent two hours or longer in the same room or vehicle as someone with COVID-19; and (iv) having been face-to-face within sixfeet or less of someone with COVID-19 for more than 15-minutes in any other setting not listed above.

Quarantine: to separate people exposed to a contagious disease and restrict their movement to determine if symptoms develop during the incubation period for the particular infectious disease outbreak.

<u>Isolation:</u> separation of sick people with a contagious disease from people who are not sick.

- Case #1 identified on April 11<sup>th</sup>, individual experienced symptoms. Individual has fully recovered.
- **Case #2** identified on April 20<sup>th</sup>, individual experienced symptoms. Individual has fully recovered
- Case #3 identified on April 29<sup>th</sup>, individual experienced symptoms. Individual was residing elsewhere. Individual has fully recovered.
- **Case #4** identified on May 6<sup>th</sup>, individual experienced symptoms. Individual has **fully recovered**.
- **Case #5** identified on May 8<sup>th</sup>. Case was asymptomatic (no symptoms). Individual has **fully recovered**.
- **Case #6 -** identified on May 13<sup>th</sup>. Case was asymptomatic (no symptoms). Individual has **fully recovered**.
- **Case #7 -** identified on May 13<sup>th</sup>. Case was asymptomatic (no symptoms). Individual has **fully recovered**.
- **Case #8** identified on June 28<sup>th</sup>. Case is asymptomatic (no symptoms).Individual has **fully recovered**.
- Case #9 identified on July 2<sup>nd</sup>. Case is asymptomatic (no symptoms). Individual has fully recovered.
- Case #10 & 11 identified on July 7th. Cases are asymptomatic (no symptoms) and have fully recovered.
- Case #12 identified on July 9th. Case is asymptomatic (no symptoms). Individual has fully recovered.
- **Case #13** identified on July 20th. Case is asymptomatic (no symptoms).Individual has **fully recovered**.
- Case #14 identified on September 25th. Case is asymptomatic (no symptoms). Individual has fully recovered.
- **Case #15** identified on Oct. 14th. Case is asymptomatic (no symptoms). Individual has **fully recovered.**

- Case #16, #17, #18 identified on Oct. 14th. All are asymptomatic and have fully recovered.
- Case #19 identified on Oct. 19th. Case is asymptomatic. Individual is isolated.
- Case #20, #21, #22, & #23 Identified on Oct. 19th. All are asymptomatic and have fully recovered.
- Case #24 identified on Oct. 21st. Case is asymptomatic.
  Individual is isolating outside of the Jemez community and all close contacts quarantining.
- Case #25 identified on Oct. 23rd. Related to cases #20-#23.
  Case is asymptomatic and fully recovered.
- Case #26, #27, #28, #29 Identified Oct. 29th. All cases are symptomatic and are isolating within the Jemez community and all close contacts quarantining.
- Case #30 identified Oct. 30th. Case is symptomatic and is isolated outside of the Jemez community and all close contacts quarantined.
- Case #31 identified on Oct. 30th. Case is symptomatic and is isolated in the Jemez community and close contacts quarantined.
- Case #32 identified on Oct. 30th. Case is symptomatic and is isolated in the Jemez community and close contacts quarantined.
- Case #33 identified on Nov. 1st. Case is asymptomatic and is isolated within the Jemez community.
- Case #34 identified Nov. 1st. Case is symptomatic and is isolated outside of the Jemez community.
- Case #35 identified Nov. 3rd. Case is symptomatic and is isolated outside of the Jemez community.
